Awareness is critical to India's tough battle against tuberculosis

Amilabh Bachchan



Mumbai is a city known far and wide for its indomitable spirit. As proud Mumbaikars, it falls on us to be well informed about looming threats that can adversely impact our city's welfare.

Tuberculosis is one such threat that has plagued our country for years despite the government's impressive Revised National TB Control Programme, and shows no signs of abating unless we as individual citizens join the efforts being made to eradicate this disease. In spite of being both preventable and treatable, TB is a largely neglected disease in India. As a result, the country records approximately 2.3 million new TB cases every year, with 3,00,000 people succumbing to the disease.

TB, much like the common cold, is a contagious and airborne infection that spreads easily and can be contracted by anyone upon exposure. It is frightening that in its initial stages many perceive TB to be a mere cough, which without timely and proper care eventually causes a great deal of physical, psychological and economic damage, and can even lead to death.

Seeking accurate TB diagnosis if a cough persists for more than two weeks will drastically improve a patient's chances of survival. Adhering to the full course of prescribed treatment is equally

important for recovery. Government provides these services for free under its programme of integrated TB care, under the Directly Observed Treatment, Short Course (DOTS) regime. However, more than half of all TB patients seek private healthcare, where malpractices in TB



diagnosis and treatment are commonplace, giving rise to deadlier drug-resistant TB.

The extent of India's TB problem became known to me when I was approached by the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) for an awareness campaign under the Mumbai

Mission for TB Control – a comprehensive strategy that was introduced in 2013, with a vision of “universal access to early TB and drug-resistant TB diagnosis, and appropriate TB treatment in the public and private sectors”. I felt humbled by the MCGM's request to be the brand ambassador of this commendable Mission.

Like the unprecedented Pulse Polio immunisation campaign, the TB awareness campaign could go a long way in strengthening MCGM's efforts towards TB prevention and control. As a strong advocate for placing greater value on the lives of our people, I freely made my disappointment known “on air” to those who detracted from or avoided the polio immunisation programme. Greatly encouraged by India's historic win against polio, I hope to contribute similarly to India's fight against TB.

The Mumbai Mission for TB Control campaign will give a much-needed push to people exhibiting symptoms of TB to immediately get diagnosed. An untreated TB patient can potentially infect another 10-15 people, underlining that TB is not an individual problem but a collective battle. The campaign urges us to support TB patients and not to stigmatise them, thereby ensuring an environment that is conducive for TB patients to seek appropriate care.

With Mumbai gallantly leading the way, let us take the fight to TB and pave the way for overcoming one of India's biggest and oldest public health problems.

SCIENTIFIC UPDATE

Tuberculosis Notification

Tuberculosis is a major public health problem in India. Early diagnosis and complete treatment of TB is the corner-stone of TB prevention and control strategy. A large number of patients due to non adherence, incomplete and inadequate treatment lead to M/XDR TB, mitigating all the efforts of the program to prevent emergence and spread of drug resistance. If the TB patients diagnosed and treated under all sectors are reported to public health authorities, then the impending epidemic of M/XDR TB can be prevented. In order to ensure proper TB diagnosis and case management, reduce TB transmission and address the problems of emergence of spread of Drug Resistant-TB, it is essential to have complete information of all TB cases.

Therefore, Govt of India declared Tuberculosis a notifiable disease on 7th May 2012, by an executive order. All public and private health providers shall notify TB cases diagnosed and/or treated by them to the nodal officers for TB notification.

Notification helps the patients to get right diagnosis, treatment, follow up, contact tracing, Chemoprophylaxis & facilitates social support systems. The clinician will continue to follow-up his/her own TB patient. In addition complete and accurate data obtained from notification will allow continuous evaluation of the trend of the disease with better estimation of burden/impact.

Indian Medical Association through IMA-GFATM-RNTCP-PPM-RCC Project has been at the forefront to sensitise private practitioners through CME and DTPs to notify their patients to respective nodal officers. The journey has been really rewarding with tremendous increase in TB notifications in the past few months across the country.

Some of the unique initiatives done by Gujarat State Branch, IMA with support from respective local branches:

- Published Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) of Tuberculosis Notification in monthly news bulletin of GSB,IMA.
- Published Tuberculosis Notification format in monthly news bulletin of GSB,IMA.
- Publishing Top 10 Tuberculosis Notifiers across Gujarat every month in the news bulletin of GSB, IMA. In this we mention the name of the doctor

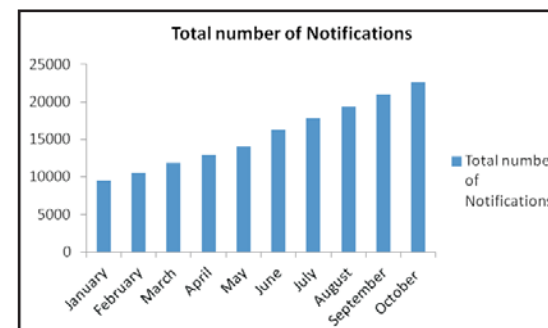


and respective District Co-ordinator's and District TB Officer's names. The motto behind this is to encourage the toppers and build a healthy relation between leaders of IMA and Government officials to generate a synergistic action towards TB eradication.

- Published summary of Standards of TB Care in India (STCI) in July monthly news bulletin of GSB, IMA.
- Ahmedabad Medical Association sent SMS to 4520 members, requesting them to notify all their Tuberculosis cases.
- Bhavnagar branch proactively circulated a TB circular to each member mentioning that TB notification is compulsory for every member and the branch is committed for the cause. Contact details of the respective District Tuberculosis Officer were also shared with all the members.

In short there is a constant endeavour and a sincere effort to educate our members to notify all the tuberculosis cases and provide quality care to Tuberculosis patients.

The journey has been a very fruitful one over the past 9-10 months. From May 2012 till end of January 2014, total notifications in Gujarat State was only 9565 and after the involvement of GSB,IMA the number rose to a staggering 22505.



This has been possible due to synergistic action of GSB,IMA along with government officials and WHO/RNTCP consultants.

Lastly, we request all the doctors to notify the tuberculosis cases and help in controlling the spread of disease in our community.

A Public Notice issued by Medical Council of India

PUBLIC NOTICE

It is hereby informed that under the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 prior permission of Central Government is required to establish a new Medical College and impart courses in modern medicine. Such permission is granted by the Central Government on the recommendation of the Medical Council of India. The admissions made by any Institution that imparts courses in modern medicine, namely, MBBS, or Diploma in various streams of medicine; MD/MS/DM/M.Ch without the prior permission of the Central Government is illegal and students so admitted shall not get recognized medical qualification entitling them to practice medicine.

It has recently come to the notice of the Medical Council of India that:

- (i) Singhania University, Pachari Bair, Distt. Jhunjunu, Rajasthan is inviting applications for MD, MBBS and Diploma courses for 2015-16.

The said institution has in its advertisement claimed that "As per legal position & opinion, a University recognized under section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956 does not require MCI approval to impart education and award degree for the same such as MBBS, MD & MS."

- (ii) Surendra Medical College and Hospital, Khagol, Patna, Bihar that is stated to be run by Surendra Hemant Education and Social Welfare Society, Patna is claiming to be a Medical College.

It may be noted that the claim so made by the Singhania University is in violation of the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the Regulations framed thereunder. Likewise, Surendra Medical College and Hospital, Khagol, Patna has never been granted any permission by the Central Government. Accordingly, any admissions that are made by



the Singhania University, Pachari Bair, Distt. Jhunjunu, Rajasthan and the Surendra Medical College and Hospital, Khagol, Patna in the courses of medicine are illegal and void ab initio.

By way of this notice all concerned are informed not to be misled by the advertisement issued by the Singhania University. Pachari Bair, Distt. Jhunjunu, Rajasthan and Surendra Medical College and Hospital, Khagol, Patna.

The updated list of Medical Colleges is available on the Medical Council of India website, i.e., www.mciindia.org along with the status of the College and number of seats approved/permitted.

All students/parents/general public are advised to check the status of Medical Colleges before taking admission in any of the Medical Colleges.

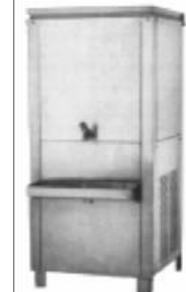

CASE NO. 1

Mrs. X, 30 years, 5th gravid 4FTMD was admitted in Maternity Hospital at fullterm with labour pain. Patient was examined and investigated for delivery.

After few hours of progress of labour pain, she was advised for LSCS.

After two hours of LSCS, bleeding from the wound persisted and she was advised for second operation – obstetric hysterectomy.

Patient's relative refused for next operation and transfered her to a higher centre.

In referral hospital she was admitted, investigated and operated for obstetric hysterectomy.

Important observations by Hon. Judge.....

Rupture of the uterus is another major complication of obstructed labour. Extremely rare in women giving birth for the first time, it may be a common occurrence in those who have borne several children. A study in Uganda found an incidence of 11 cases of ruptured uterus per 1000 deliveries (27), compared with 16 per 1000 deliveries in a study from Ghana (28), 2.4 per 1000 in a study from India (29), and 7.4 per 1000 in a study from Honduras (30). Once the uterus ruptures there is severe pain and tenderness over it, heavy bleeding from the torn vessels of the uterus follows and death results from hemorrhage and shock within 24 hours, or from infection later. Surgical treatment, aimed at arresting the bleeding is always is to survive. This is achieved either by repairing the tear in the uterus or by removing the uterus (hysterectomy).

Women with a multiple pregnancy and those who have had four or more previous births are particularly at risk of postpartum hemorrhage, probably because the uterine muscles have been overstretched and are less able to contract normally.

Heavy bleeding can also result from injuries caused during childbirth, either spontaneously or during operative delivery. Rupture of the uterus, tears in the cervix and vagina, and injuries lower down the birth canal and the perineum can all cause hemorrhage.

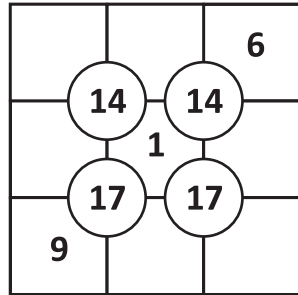
