compromised way out. We are quite sure that soon we shall be able to find a middle way in this.

Lessons from COVID 19

We seem to have gone past the worst crisis of our life time, as COVID 19 looks to have peaked out for now. We also realised that this is not the last disaster that we have faced. Our health care system was overwhelmed with massive number of sick patients and our doctors, nurses and other support staff responded bravely, often at the cost of their own safety and lives. This dedication and sense of duty set a great example of how doctors selflessly serve the society. Our Prime Minister and the Government also recognised the role played by our dedicated doctors, who saved so many lives in this worst pandemic of the century.

This pandemic has offered a plenty of lessons for all of us - individual medical practitioners, doctors practising in public and private hospitals and also those, managing our public, private and corporate hospitals. Some of them are as follows: **Be ready with plans for sudden increase in demand for health care services:** We encounter small and large, either man made or natural disasters regularly and it is very critical that we have plans in place as to how should we deal with such exceptional situations. We should also review such plans periodically and undertake mock drills on regular basis. That will strengthen our capabilities to respond to such disasters and make our health systems more resilient.

Use of Technology: One important lesson that comes out prominently, from our COVID 19 response, is the use of technology during the epidemic. Use of telemedicine was very extensive during those days and despite some limitations, tele-consult has become one of the most acceptable way to offer advice and consultation for medical practitioners. Technology was also used widely for other uses during pandemic and we all stand to benefit from that. There are a number of such success stories where health care services and systems used technology, internet based services, e commerce platforms and even the delivery of critical medical supplies and vaccines through drones. Our COWIN platform used for

vaccination has become a very successful technology and this platform was offered to so many other countries by India.

Ensure robust supply chain: We realised that there was shortage of critical devices like lifesaving drugs and devices from time to time. Even oxygen also came at premium. Some medicines just disappeared from the market. Similar situation was seen in supplies of masks, other disposable items and medical devices. To address such massive unexpectedly high demands of medical supplies, we should diversify our supply chain and sources, from where we procure our medical goods. This particular problem was just not only local but this agenda has also caught global attention. Now so many countries want to reduce their dependence on outside suppliers. India is also taking multiple steps in this direction by encouraging indigenous manufacturing of bio pharmaceuticals and medical devices.

Strengthen our Surveillance and data collection systems: This will help us anticipate such disasters much earlier before the situation escalates. With early notification our response will be robust and timely. This will help us to develop a stronger medical response, implement preventive measures and even hasten our vaccine development effort, in time to contain the damaging consequences of such an epidemic.

Emotional Support to health care staff: Welost of a lot of our colleagues in this pandemic. Stress levels ran very high amongst doctors, paramedical professionals and even their families. Some of our colleagues had to work days and days continuously, without any break. Conversely, some of colleagues and specialists were not able to practice for months and suffered massive loss of income. All these situations require a lot of emotional and psychological support to our colleagues who suffer from such problems. Mental health is often a neglected area, even amongst the doctors!

The best way to pay tribute to our doctor colleagues, we lost to COVID-19, would be by learning from the experience and implement those lessons that could help our patients and save their lives. I believe that the some of the lessons we have learned from the pandemic, would also improve the hospital care and health care delivery in both - our daily practice and would also help us to better prepare ourselves for future such pandemics.

To, Shri Narendra Modi ji Honourable Prime Minister of India Government of India

Respected and beloved Prime Minister,

Pranaam

We bring you the respect and esteem of the modern medicine doctors of India. We wish to bring to your attention some important issues of the medical profession for your consideration.

- 1. There has been a policy shift to introduce integrative medicine. IMA wishes to submit that every system of medicine is unique in its own way and has a distinct identity and profile. Modern medicine has made huge strides in India and has to be accepted as a legacy than a colonial vestige. The life span of an Indian has increased from 27 in 1947 to 70 in 2023. Modern maternal and child health services, eradication of small pox, polio, neonatal tetanus as well as control of Tuberculosis and other infectious diseases have contributed to this phenomenal Health achievement. We could stop Covid on its tracks because of the vaccine and modern medicine doctors manned our Pandemic services. It is estimated around 2000 modern medicine doctors laid down their lives in our war against Covid. Indian medical colleges are amongst the oldest in the world and are rightfully our legacy. Indian doctors are our best ambassadors and add a legion to our soft power. Today India is the proud capital of modern medicine effectively blending clinical medicine with evidence based medicine. The effort to integrate irreconcilable systems will lead onto loss of our leadership in modern medicine. Chinese Traditional Medicine got decimated in such a process. The purity and existence of Ayurveda is under threat by opting for Integrative Medicine. We wish to say that we are the leaders in affordable and accessible healthcare and China is not our role model. IMA appeals to you to preserve the purity of all systems to retain the choice of our people. IMA is apprehensive that Integrative Medicine will set us back by a century and cause irreparable damage leading onto loss of countless lives.
- 2. Violence on doctors and hospitals has become commonplace and can no longer be ignored. Fear rules our hospitals. Young doctors manning our emergencies and ICUs as well as the Obstetricians are in the front lines of such attacks though no one is safe. Physical abuse, trial by media and cyber trolling are order of the day. 25 states have law on attack on doctors and hospitals. They are mostly ineffective on ground and do not serve the purpose of deterrence. The absence of a special central enactment is one of the reasons. It is pointed out that the airline staff have been given a special status and protection under a special law while the doctors and nurses have been left alone to fend



for themselves. Your Government partially mitigated the situation during the pandemic by amending the ancient Epidemic diseases Act 1897. Hospitals are recognised as safe zones even in war. It is unacceptable that they are targeted in peace. Violence on doctors and hospitals is a complex issue and would require a sophisticated and effective response. The Central law against violence on doctors and hospitals could only be a beginning.

- 3. The advent of a new regulator in medical education has led to amateurish experimenting affecting the medical students of the nation. One of these avoidable sluggers fast is the confusion compounded by introduction of a licentiate exam NeXT 2 at the end of compulsory internship and deeming it the entrance exam for postgraduate studies as well. It is illogical to evaluate the least common denominator of being licensed and to identify the best students for post-graduation by a single examination. This will be an injustice to students who wish to join Government service or begin general practice after graduation. The least that could be done is to decouple postgraduate selection. This is not to exonerate the idea of NeXT 1 which is a violation of the Universities Act. The idea of licensing is alien and our medical education has done us proud as evidenced by an omnipresent and competent medical diaspora.
- 4. The institution of National Board of Examinations has done well to produce highly competent specialists and super special specialists from non-teaching institutions. It will be in prudence of things to retain and nurture this institution rather than merge the same with NMC which is saddled with many responsibilities all at once.
- 5. Time has come to review all the legislations governing the medical practice including medical negligence. Criminal prosecution in the absence of mens rhea, alterations of the doctor patient relationship to one of consumer and provider, the collateral damage suffered by the profession by the biased structure of the PCPNDT Act and the POCSO Act are few of the many which need to be reviewed in a way aligning the profession with the national interest without alienating.

In a true sense doctor are in a state of fear and harassment from all directions. They deserve solace and succour especially after the crucial Covid war. They certainly need a new deal. We in IMA have high hopes that your administration will hear the voice of the medical profession. Redressal of the grievances of the doctors and medical students of India is awaiting your favourable consideration.

For Local Branches


- 1. All local branches shall cooperate with District level activity.

"World Kidney Day" – 9th March 2023

The Slogan of this year's World Kidney Day is 'KIDNEY HEALTH FOR ALL -. *Preparing for the unexpected and supporting the vulnerable!*

The last three years have been very tumultuous for the world. It started with COVID-19 pandemic, the Ukraine war followed by earthquake, floods and extreme weather. This has resulted in redistribution of resources and less being spent for non-communicable diseases like chronic kidney disease. The low- and middle-income countries have been particularly hit hard where the bulk of the patients reside. Therefore, preparation for unexpected events is incredibly important for kidney patients.

Chronic kidney disease is the sixth fastest-growing cause of death globally and around 1.7 million people are estimated to die annually because of acute kidney injury globally. In India, it is estimated that a population of over 7.8 million people are living with chronic kidney diseases."

In view of the increasing incidence of kidney disease and the need for raising awareness World Kidney Day was started in 2006. Genetically people from South Asian geographical regions i.e. India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Srilanka have higher risk of kidney disease especially with increasing rates of Diabetes and Hypertension.

Diabetes is the number one reason for kidney failure in India. Kidney failure is a silent disease and it does not manifest until 60% to 70% function is lost.

1 in 10 people worldwide suffers from some degree of Chronic Kidney disease and it can occur at any age plus various risk factors can accelerate it.

Twenty million people have Chronic Kidney Disease globally and of these 7.8 million are from India. In Chronic Kidney Disease there is a gradual deterioration of kidney function, the end result of which is kidney failure.

7 Most Important tips of health kidneys are:

- 1. Keep fit and avoid sedentary lifestyle
- 2. Check and manage your blood sugar levels
- 3. Have a healthy balanced diet
- 4. Check and maintain the ideal blood pressure levels
- 5. Drink appropriate fluids (8 cups or nearly 2 litres per day)
- 6. Abstinence from Alcohol and tobacco consumption
- 7. Avoid regular intake of non-steroidal anti-inflammatory (pain killer medication) and other kidney damaging drugs.

Get your kidney functions checked periodically if you have any or more risk factors like:

- Have diabetes
- 2. Have hypertension
- 3. Are obese
- 4. Have family history of Kidney disease



The key to discover early kidney disease is doing routine checks like urine tests, getting blood pressure and sugar checked periodically. Early detection can help postpone kidney failure through low cost medication.

Common early and late symptoms of kidney disease include:

- 1. Tiredness and exhaustion
- 2. Nausea and vomiting
- 3. Confusion, anxiety and restless.
- 4. Passing little or no urine
- 5. Swelling in the body especially of legs and feet
- 6. Loss of appetite with weight loss
- 7. Itching
- 8. Breathlessness

Kidney replacement can take place through transplantation. A patient can also have either blood or water dialysis called Haemodialysis, or peritoneal Dialysis to filter the wastes of the body. However, kidney transplantation remains the best method to replace a lost kidney. It provides the best quality of life and also is cost effective compared to dialysis.

What can be done to Help patients with Kidney Failure ?

IMA recommends and promotes organ donation on the world kidney day as organ donation is life saving and safe for the donor and has excellent benefits to the recipient. Organ donation can be done by any healthy person especially Kidney and liver with no long-term side effects to the donor.

A brain dead patient can donate (Cadaver transplant) apart from Kidneys and liver other organs also like heart, lungs, liver and pancreas. One brain dead patient can save 8 lives. The problem in India is the scarcity of organs for transplants. Number of patients needing kidney transplant in India is estimated to be 2,20,000 annually and we are currently doing only 7,500 kidney transplants against the same. 90% of these are from living donors and 10% are from the brain dead (Cadaver) donors.

IMA appeals for healthy care of your kidneys and also promotes the concept of organs donations. It supports initiative of Government Bodies such as NOTTO to improve the donation rate in our country.


