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

#### STATE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear Doctor Colleagues,

Today I feel very happy and blessed to have become president of Gujarat State Branch of Indian Medical Association.

In 1989, I was inspired to join in the service and in activities of IMA by my senior friend and inspiratory legend, dearly respected in our heart as "The Boss", Dr. Ketan Desai. And since last 33 years, I have continuously remained active in service of IMA.

Today, to become "Pradhan/Mukhya Sevak" of thirty three thousand doctors of Gujarat, is a proud moment and a privilege for me.

In the last 33 years journey, I am trained and nurtured by seniors and members of all zones, namely –Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Rajkot, Surat, West & South.

In these days, when IMA is facing difficult situations and multi-lateral challenges, only our unity will become and remain our strength.

Socially, politically or religiously, we may be part of various groups and factions at personal and individual levels; but for the IMA, we have to get united and use all our social and political might and will power for IMA; keeping "IMA first, IMA must" as our guiding motto & a light house like principle.

#### Main tasks before us in this coming year are:-

 Membership Drive:- Number of medical colleges and number of their seats are increasing every year. So, there are abundant numbers of doctors coming out every year. We should enroll at least 5 to 100 new members per branch, depending upon city and size of the branch. Strengthening women's wing, junior doctors wing will help us to bring them closer and

attract them to join; and even having students and intern wings, we can instill in them seeds of desire to become members in near future.

- 2) We shall organize zonal and branch vise seminars about Professional Protection Scheme, Social Security Scheme, Health Scheme and Family Welfare Scheme. Even to small center members, we must reach out and explain them the benefits of these schemes.
- 3) In every possible center, it will be our endeavor to create medico-legal cells., and organize seminars on "legal literacy". We shall try our best to educate members, how to have proper and diplomatic language while discussing every pros and cons of a medical or surgical therapy. This is very important in this media era. Rather than patients or relatives secretly recording our conservation while explaining, we should officially video or audio record the entire process of giving consultation and advises to patients and especially to relatives, more so to possibly notorious relatives and their social activists.
- 4) Like political parties, it is now high time that every IMA branch should have their/our own Media handling and IT team. We should also have a "rapid action force" teams of friends in every branch.
- 5) In case of any disputes between member doctor and patients or relative, even if it is just a hot verbal, and in cases of any violence or threats of, against members; we must soon move the police into it, and take all necessary judicial steps. Taking official steps against many such relative, will slowly help us in general, to curb down such incidences.
- 6) To warm up and make more cordial the doctor patient relations, we will also organize doctor-patient-relatives seminars, taking help from NGOs and religious santhas
- 7) To make sure that all orders which are coming from national and state Head Quarter of IMA are followed strictly by all members, we shall organize frequent online meetings with presidents and secretaries of state branches.
- 8) Mix-o-pathy hospitals acts, fire safety NOC, Bio medical waste etc. rules are to be followed by all of us. But we should also have to make the government and their authorities to understand to implement such acts and laws with proper understanding of local circumstances with favorable discretion, without discrimination. We shall have proper and good dialogue with government/s about this.


- 9) We shall also have good dialogue with government to have improvement in their health services, for which they should take expert doctors in advisory committee, and to have increase in health budget. Also, we shall request government to increase number of MBBS doctors in rural area, rather than just increasing Ayush doctors.
- 10) We will also request government to increase salary, incentives and other allowances for MBBS and PG doctors.
- 11) Allopathy system is the most scientific of all medical systems of the world. However, many persons of other pathies do advertise and make intended propaganda against our system. We shall take staunch and firm stand against such persons, and if needed, bring them to courts of law. We will prevent them from claiming that "their pathy is superior to allopathy"
- 12) We will also make sure to take strict actions against our own members, who's behavior is to break our unity, who are doing advertisements and bill boards and hoardings, breaking the ethics of our noble profession.
- 13) We shall also encourage ad guide IMA branches to run their own Bio medical waste disposal systems, and be "atmanirbhar" in this regards.
- 14) I am very happy to inform and invite all members to attend a one day medico-spiritual conference organized by IMA-GSB, at Pramukh Swami Shatabdi Nagar, Ahmedabad on 18th December 2022. For this conference, our venue host is BAPS sanstha on the occasion of PSM-100. This conference will also give a nice opportunity to visit the nagar-darshan in a specially arranged guided VIP tour.
- 15) Before I conclude, I strongly appeal and request all our members, to canvass for and support our doctor members who are contesting as candidate in coming Gujarat Assembly elections.

The medical fraternity and its members are now regularly facing backlash and are being dragged to the court of law to face many

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

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## Primary tracheal Hyalinizing clear cell carcinoma (Clear cell carcinoma) – A rare salivary gland type neoplasm

Hyalinizing clear cell carcinoma (HCCC) was first described in 1994 by Milchgrub et al. in their series of 11 patientsas a distinctive low-grade carcinoma predominantly occurring in the intraoral minor salivary glands, more commonly in middle-aged women. It is composed of cords, nests, islands and trabeculae of monomorphic glycogen rich clear and eosinophilic cells infiltrating a characteristic juxtaposition hyalinized and fibro cellular stroma. Hyalinizing clear cell carcinomas (HCCC), now referred to as clear cell carcinomas (CCC) by the World Health Organization (WHO).

In approximately 80% of patients, the primary tumour is located within the oral cavity, involving the minor salivary glands; the most frequent site of occurrence being the tongue and palate, which account for >50% of tumours. Other less common sites include the parotid gland, subglottic larynx, nasopharynx, and hypopharynx. Tumour metastasis has been reported in up to 25% of patients at initial presentation, primarily to regional lymph nodes and rarely to the lung. Primary tracheal HCCC is an extremely rare and very few cases have been reported till date.


We present here a case of a 63 year old lady presented with dyspnoea. On CECT there was a polypoidal lesion along right lateral wall of upper trachea (D2 - D3 spine level), causing partial narrowing of tracheal lumen. Under bronchoscopy evaluation: there was a submucosal elevated lesion. Over lying mucosa was non ulcerated.

We have received transbronchial biopsy from tumour for histopathological examination. The tumour was located submucosally with the overlying mucosa was ulcerated. The tumour was composed of nests of cells with monomorphic nuclei and water clear cytoplasm and set in a hyalinised and septae. Few cells were with eosinophilic cytoplasm are seen. At periphery, lymphocytic infiltrate is seen. No mitosis or marked pleomorphism or necrosis are seen.


Based on morphological findings, few differential diagnosis were offered as possibility of salivary gland tumour (Myoepithelioma / clear cell carcinoma) or paraganglioma.

Keeping with these differential diagnosis, panel of immunohistochemistry was performed and also special stains. The tumour cells were positive for CK 7, EMA, p40, p63 and CK 5/6. They were negative for S 100, c-kit,

synaptophysin, chromogranin A, TTF1/ Napsin A and Vimentin. The cells were positive for PAS stain and negative for d-PAS. The Ki 67 prolifertion index was very low.

We have received wide local excision of this tumour with regional lymph node dissection. It was measuring  $1.7 \times 1.5 \times 1.2$  cm with yellowish white, solid firm and homogenous appearance and firm in consistency. On microscopy similar morphology as of biopsy specimen was seen. No necrosis, haemorrhage or increased mitosis or pleomorphism noted. No tumour emboli noted. Margins of excision were free of tumour and regional lymph nodes were free of metastasis.

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

વડોદરા ઓળંગી ત્યાં ક્લાઈટમાં બેસેલી યુવતિને અચાનક ચક્કર આવતા બેભાન થઇ ગઈ હતી. જેથી તેમની સાથે જ મુસાફરી કરતા રાજકોટના બે તબીબ દંપતિએ વિમાનમાં જ યુવતિને પ્રાથમિક સારવાર આપતા તે બચી ગઈ. જે બાદ જણાવે છે કે, આજે સવારે ૭.૨૫ વાગ્યે દિલ્હીથી ફ્લાઈટમાં રાજકોટ આવી રહ્યા હતા ત્યારે ફ્લાઈટ ઉપડચાના અડધો કલાકમાં વડોદરા પહોચી ત્યાં જ એક યુવતિને અચાનક ચક્કર આવતા બેભાન થઇ ગઈ. જેથી તુરંત એરલાઈન્સ પાસેના તબીબી સાધનો મારફ્ત યુવતિને હાર્ટ પર મસાજ કર્યુ અને ગ્લુકોઝનું

ઇન્જેક્શન આપ્યું. જે બાદ યુવતિની નસોમાં લોહી પહોચતું ન હોવાથી તેના પગ ઉપર અને માથું નીચે રાખવામાં આવ્યું. દરમિયાન ઓક્સિજન પણ અપાયો. ફ્લાઈટ રાજકોટ પહોચવાને ૨૫ મિનીટનો સમય હતો ત્યારે જ આ ઘટના બની પરંતુ પ્રાથમિક સારવાર મળી જતા યુવતિ સ્વસ્થ થઈ ગઈ.

## **ABOUT THE PROGRAMME**

Medical Law is a scientific field that concerns the rights and duties of Medical Professionals as well as patients. The changing scenario of public health to a fundamental human right entrusts a huge responsibility on the medical professionals. Detailed knowledge on legislations governing varied aspects of Medical Practice is inevitable for the Medical Professionals. In majority of the developed nations, Medical Law has gained the status of a separate discipline, studied with the cooperation of Law schools and Medical schools.

The knowledge of Medical Laws will enable the Medical Practitioners to develop critical thinking about legal, ethical and professional issues and also to take decisions which are professionally, ethically and legally justifiable. In this era of globalization and the increasing challenges encountered due to health emergencies, it becomes essential for medical professionals to understand the stand of international law and domestic law in ensuring healthcare to public.

The programme will offer the opportunity to study the contemporary legal and ethical challenges faced by those working in the healthcare sector. The course aims to acquaint the medical practitioners with the evolving issues such as assisted reproduction, abortion, genetics, mental health, standards of medical treatment, transplantation medicine, euthanasia health research, advanced directives/decisions, and the allocation of scarce resources.





#### Guideline on Aesthetic Surgery and Hair Transplant Procedures

#### Hair transplantation:

Any procedure involving a skin incision for the purpose of tissue removal from the scalp or body, or to prepare the scalp or body to receive tissue, (e.g., incising the FUE graft, excising the donor strip, creating recipient sites) by any means, including robotics, is a surgical procedure. Such procedures must be performed by a properly trained and licensed Registered Medical Practitioner (RMP) i.e practitioner of Modem Medicine: RMPs who perform hair restoration surgery must possess the education, training and current competency in the field of hair restoration surgery like adequate knowledge in hair physiology, pathogenesis of scarring and non-scarring alopecia, anatomy and physiology of scalp including scalp vasculature and nerve supply, adequate clinical skill to identify patients Who are candidates for hair, transplant surgery and contraindications for hair transplant including active scarring alopecia, adequate knowledge and clinical skill pertaining to the medical treatment of alopecia and pre and post-transplant medical care, acquired basic knowledge and skill base in surgeries pertaining to skin and its appendages, adequate training and knowledge pertaining to medical issues and possible adverse reactions that can arise during the hair transplant surgery including basic life support and resuscitation measures.

The hair transplant should preferably be undertaken only by those who have surgical grooming like formal surgical training such as MCh/DNB Plastic surgery, MD/DNB Dermatology with adequate grooming in dermatological surgical procedures. It is also noted that the above-named specialties have Hair transplantation as a core topic in their Curriculum.

The following aspects of hair restoration surgery should only be performed by a RMP:

- Preoperative diagnostic evaluation
- Surgery planning
- Surgery execution including: Donor hair harvesting, Hairline design. Recipient site creation and Management of other patient medical issues and possible adverse reactions
- Post-operative care

It is unethical for a RMP to train an individual to perform/assist surgery who is not an accredited health professional licensed to do so.

#### Minimum requirements in a hospital/clinic performing hair transplant surgery

The day care theatre should he equipped with facilities for monitoring and handling emergencies including stocking of emergency drugs, Boyles machine, intubation sets and ambu bag. A plan for handling emergencies should be in place and all nursing staff should be familiar with the emergency plan. It is ideal to have a standby anaesthetist.

#### Aesthetic Procedures:

Aesthetic Procedures should be undertaken only by those RMPs who have adequate training o do these procedures as per their curriculum.

So, curriculum of various specialties should be guiding principle for all RMP's while undertaking any procedure including aesthetics & Hair transplant procedures.

#### Aesthetic Procedures including Hair Transplant:

Aesthetic Procedures including Hair Transplant as with any other surgical procedure, may have complications and requires skills and training in appropriate patient selection, differential diagnoses and surgical. techniques and appropriate post procedure care to optimize outcomes. It is suggested that anyone who wishes to perform these procedures should be adequately knowledgeable and trained and should ensure that they have adequate infrastructure and manpower to manage any issues that may arise due to procedure performed.

Aesthetic Procedures including Hair Transplant are not an Emergency Surgery, and hence there is no case for allowing any untrained person to do it under the pretext of "Exceptional Circumstances". Para 6 of the Judgment mentions "Hair transplantation being an aesthetic surgery needs to be performed by RMPs like qualified dermatologists or trained surgeons".

- I It may be noted that watching in workshops or on YouTube or similar platforms is not adequate training to start Aesthetic surgeries including hair transplant.
- II Assistants or OT technicians; should be from a medical background, such as nurses, lab technicians, pharmacists. However, they need to be provided structured, systematic, and proper training (responsibility will lie with the RMP) in all aspects of both aesthetic surgery and disinfection, sterilization, patient communication etc.
- III Surgical assistants/technicians should perform tasks only under the supervision of a RMP.

The RMP should have an anesthesia back up in the form of presence of the anesthetist in the operation room area with all the requisite resuscitative equipment and drugs in place,

The RMP should ensure that the patient undergoing such a surgery should have adequate preoperative clearances from the medical specialists and the anesthetist.

The RMP should have a well-equipped postoperative recovery room with facilities for monitoring of vitals and adequate record keeping.

#### Manpower and Infrastructure required at place of such procedure

#### Manpower :-

Apart from the surgeon performing hair transplantation and Aesthetic surgery, the centre should also have trained OT personnel like staff nurses, technicians, OT masters etc.

#### Infrastructure:-

- 1. It should be a hospital with facilities for treating indoor patients.
- 2. There should be properly set up operation theatre with all OT protocols being followed or implemented strictly like
  - Strict asepsis and fumigation protocols.
  - Proper biomedical waste management like separation, transfer/transport and disposal.
  - Proper sterilization of instruments, drapes etc.
- 3. Availability of anaesthetist as it is an Invasive OT procedure. Crash cart trolley should be available with all resuscitative facilities.
- 4. If it is a clinic doing day care surgeries only, then it should be well connected with any nearby hospital with proper ICU and critical care facilities, if needed in case of any emergency and with a display of 24 hrs emergency number forhelp.
- 5. Proper records of operated patients with pre and post operative photographs, records of any complication need to be maintained.


