PUBLIC NOTICE

It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned:

That for FMG (Foreign Medical Graduates), the degree awarded by foreign universities such as "MD (Physician)", "MD (Doctor of Medicine)", and the registration/license granted by NMC, MCI, or GMC under equivalent titles like "MD (Physician)" or "MD (Doctor of Medicine)" is considered equivalent to MBBS in accordance with Regulation 2(f) of the Screening Test Regulations, 2002.

However, it has been observed that some FMGs, despite this equivalence, are misrepresenting their qualifications/registration as being on par with "MD" and thereby misleading the general public.

All FMGs registered with the Gujarat Medical Council are directed to practice only as "M.B.B.S." doctors (as recognized for equivalence in India). They must mention only "M.B.B.S." as their qualification in every professional context. This requirement is mandatory for signboards, prescriptions, visiting cards, letterheads, advertisements, and all other forms of public or professional representation. Any projection of foreign titles such as "MD (Physician)" or "MD (Doctor of Medicine)" in India shall be treated as misrepresentation.

All FMGs are hereby cautioned that such misrepresentation amounts to professional and ethical misconduct. As per Section 30(2) of the NMC Act, 2019, any violation of the above shall invite disciplinary action by the Council, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the concerned medical practitioner, which may include:

- Suspension of MBBS registration for a period which may extend to six (06) months, or
- Imposition of monetary penalty which may extend to ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only), or
- Both, depending upon the severity of the misconduct.

All stakeholders, including hospitals, institutions, and the general public, are advised to take note of the above.

PUBLIC NOTICE

It is hereby brought to the notice of all concerned that under **Section 34 (1) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (No.30 of 2019) published in the official extra ordinary Gazette of Government of India in PART II – Section 1 on Thursday 8th August, 2019 by Ministry of Law and Justice (Legislative Department),**

(1) No person other than a person who is enrolled in the **Gujarat Medical Council State Register** or the **National Medical Commission's National Register**, as the case may be shall:

- (a) be allowed to practice medicine as a qualified medical practitioner in the state of Gujarat;
- (b) hold office as a physician or surgeon, or any other office, by whatever name called, which is meant to be held by a physician or surgeon in the state of Gujarat;
- (c) be entitled to sign or authenticate a medical or fitness certificate or any other certificate required by any law to be signed or authenticated by a duly qualified medical practitioner in the state of Gujarat;
- (d) be entitled to give evidence at any inquest or in any court of law as an expert under section 45 of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 on any matter relating to medicine in the state of Gujarat;

(2) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section without **registration of the Gujarat Medical Council** shall be **punished with:**

- **Imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year, or**
- **with fine which may extend to five lakh rupees, or**
- **with both.**

Therefore, all persons are hereby **mandated to ensure registration with the Gujarat Medical Council** before engaging in any medical practice in the State of Gujarat.

Strict compliance with the above is required.

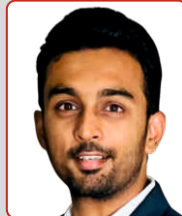

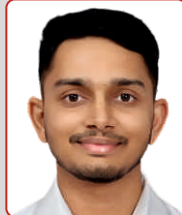

Fact: Surgery is a tool, not magic. Patients typically lose 60–80% of their excess weight depending on the type of procedure, adherence to lifestyle changes, and individual metabolism.

Myth: Bariatric surgery is very risky

Fact: Modern bariatric surgery is very safe. Minimally invasive techniques have drastically reduced complications and recovery time.

Myth: After surgery, you can never enjoy food again.

Fact: Patients can still enjoy a wide variety of foods, but portion sizes are smaller, and healthier choices are encouraged. Over time, patients learn to enjoy food mindfully and without guilt.

Myth: You will regain all the weight after a few years.

Fact: Most patients maintain significant weight loss for years, especially with consistent follow-up care, nutrition counselling, and exercise. Regain can occur but is usually partial and preventable.

Myth: Pregnancy is unsafe after bariatric surgery.

Fact: Bariatric surgery often improves fertility and pregnancy outcomes. Doctors usually recommend waiting 12–18 months after surgery before conceiving to allow weight and nutrition to stabilize.

Myth: Bariatric surgery causes severe malnutrition.

Fact: While certain procedures (like gastric bypass) can reduce nutrient absorption, proper supplementation and regular monitoring prevent deficiencies. Most patients remain healthy with guided follow-up.



Myth: Anyone can get bariatric surgery if they want to.

Fact: Bariatric surgery requires a thorough evaluation by a multidisciplinary team (surgeon, dietician, and psychologist). Patients must meet specific medical criteria and demonstrate readiness for lifelong changes.

Myth: Bariatric surgery leaves huge scars and a long recovery.

Fact: Most bariatric procedures are done laparoscopically or robotically, leaving only small incisions. Many patients go home the next day and resume light activities.

Myth: You will be bedridden or weak after surgery.

Fact: Early mobilization is encouraged. Most patients are walking on the day of surgery and regain energy as they lose weight and their health improves.

Myth: Bariatric surgery causes hair loss permanently.

Fact: Some temporary hair thinning can occur 3–6 months after surgery due to rapid weight loss, but hair usually regrows with proper nutrition and supplementation.

Myth: Surgery will “cure” all obesity-related conditions overnight.

Fact: Many conditions like type 2 diabetes, hypertension, and sleep apnoea improve or even go into remission, but this can take months and still requires ongoing medical monitoring.

4. AS 13 - Investment

5. Other Notes

1. Social Security Scheme is a wing of IMA Gujarat State Branch ,Ahmedabad registered under the Gujarat Trust Act as well as under the Income Tax Act.
 2. The object of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the nominee of expired members.
 3. The Scheme has paid Death fraternity to nominee of 126 expired members.
 6. Amounts received as membership subscription from each member enrolled during the year has been taken to Corpus Fund.

 9. Previous year figures have been regrouped and rearranged, wherever necessary to make them comparable with those of current year.
 10. The amount paid, during the earlier year, to nominees of deceased members, and receivable during the current year, outstanding at the beginning of year on 01.04.24 being Rs. 1,83,69,300/- was received by Rs 1,71,53,202/- I & E less by Rs. 9,33,048/- now not receivable from Members at the end of the year, considering amount receivable from each individual members has been written off and debited to Income and expenses account.
 11. The managing committee of scheme, vide its meeting held on 24/02/2024 held at the office of the scheme passed a resolution that Every active and retired Members* of this scheme shall have to pay Rs. 1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) as Brotherhood Fraternity Contribution (BFC) yearly, and accordingly 10310 members has paid the contribution which has been credited to Income & Expenditure A/c. However, 1650 members has not paid Rs. 1,500/-.



HOW I DO – DVT - Other Important Points- PART – 16

Question: In last part, we covered some important points related to VTEPREVENTION 1. Over four hours of air travel should be considered for DVT prophylaxis, especially if other risk factors exist e.g. cancer, obesity, past history of VTE, genetic factor. Stay mobile and hydrated. Avoid alcohol. Use of medicines is highly variable. 2. We reviewed list of patients considered high risk for DVT during hospitalization. 3. Indian data is small and variable. With change in lifestyle, our incidence of western diseases is increasing. Hence DVT prophylaxis should be more seriously considered. 4. VTE is the Number 1 Preventable Cause of Death in hospitalized patients. 5. Most common drug used is LMWH e.g. enoxaparin 0.4 mg subcutaneous once a day. In some cases, fondaparinux, unfractionated heparin, or even oral agents can be used for prophylaxis. Mechanical compression devices are used only when medicines are contraindicated.

Are there any other important points related to DVT/PE that we need to highlight?

Answer: Yes this is a very wide topic. But let us briefly review few important points:

1. **Duration** of Anticoagulation for those with a DVT only, and a **transient risk factor**. e.g. post surgery, or immobilization, is **3 months**. Longer anticoagulation is not required. Also, these patients should NOT be tested for hereditary risk factors.

2. Those with DVT **without any obvious transient risk factor** need a longer duration of anticoagulation i.e. at least six months, preferably longer if there is low risk for bleeding. How long is not defined, but it is advised as **long term, indefinite** if bleeding risk is lower. Basically balancing risk of recurrent DVT versus bleeding. If risk of bleeding is high, stop at 3 months or longer. But if risk is medium, you can use lower dose NOAC/DOAC to extend anticoagulation. This lower dose is preferred over only aspirin. However, if NOAC is not feasible for some reasons, aspirin can be used for longer duration anticoagulation.

No test is used to guide duration of anticoagulation e.g. D dimer, repeated venous doppler to look for residual thrombosis or any risk scores. Basically if DVT is unprovoked, the risk for recurrent DVT outweighs risk of bleeding in general. Unless there are obvious risk factors for bleeding.

3. For those with **pulmonary embolism**, same principle apply as for unprovoked DVT, with regard to duration of anticoagulation.

4. **Goal INR for patients on warfarin** for almost all indications is between 2 and 3. Higher or lower are not advised.

5. There are specific guidelines re **reversal of warfarin** based on presence of any bleeding, and level of PT/INR. For asymptomatic no bleeding, only high INR, FFP or PCC are avoided. For those with critical bleed or need for urgent surgery, PCC (prothrombin complex concentrate) are preferred. For others, low dose vitamin k or just holding warfarin are advised, depending on level of PT/INR. If PCC is not available, FFP is next choice. Novoseven (rFactorVIIa) can also be used, though not preferred.

6. **Reversal of DOAC** depends on which specific DOAC is in use. There are different products for different DOAC. **PCC can be used if** specific antidote is not available. FFP alone is too weak to have significant effect, but can be used if no other option, considering cost of PCC.

Activated charcoal can be used if taken within two hours. **Dialysis can be used to clear Dabigatran.**

If more than 24 hours have passed since last dose of DOAC, and renal function is normal, reversal is not required.

7. Guidelines recommend **against use of** compression stocking as a routine measure to prevent post thrombotic syndrome.

8. Some patients are found to have incidental **subsegmental pulmonary embolism** during CT scan of chest done for other reasons. What to do with these patients, who have no DVT, but only subsegmental PE? CHEST guidelines recommend observation alone for these patients if they are otherwise low risk for VTE. But if they are at otherwise high risk for VTE e.g. cancer patients, then they should receive standard anticoagulation.

9. For **obese** patients, standard DOAC dosing can be used up to 120 kg weight.

10. For many DVT patients, otherwise stable, **oral DOAC can be started as first line of therapy** without any injectable treatment. Many of these can be treated as outpatient, if there is good follow up and monitoring possible. Outpatient treatment should be tried in very highly selected patients in India, considering our support services and patient reliability.

11. **Know which DOAC you are using**, preferably use same for all patients. This way you and your team will be very conversant with dosing. For example, only dabigatran has a fixed dose from day one. Rivaroxaban and Apixaban have a **loading dose** for 21 and 7 days respectively. I see a number of patients where loading dose is continued or starting dose is lower. Rivaroxaban is preferably given after food. Other issue we see is patients with worsening renal function continuing same dose DOAC. Or no **monitoring of creatinine** for several months to years. Patients and physicians frequently take these medicines lightly. We recently had a patient with high creatinine, on rivaroxaban for a prolonged period, came in with bleeding. 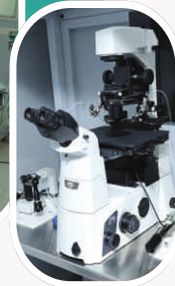

[INTERESTING CASE: A VERY RARE OCCURENCE OF SEVERE APLASTIC ANEMIA WITH A PAROXYSMAL NOCTURNAL HEMOGLOBINURIA CLONE IN AN ADOLESCENT WITH SICKLE CELL DISEASE SUCCESSFULLY TREATED WITH STEM CELL TRANSPLANT](#)

BackGround:

Sickle-cell disease (SCD) is one of the most common severe genetic disorders worldwide. In SCD, individuals demonstrate an increased adhesiveness of blood cells, including red blood cells, neutrophils, eosinophils and platelets; this plays a fundamental role in the vaso-occlusive process. Aplastic Anemia (AA) is characterized by peripheral blood pancytopenia and a hypocellular bone marrow. Paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria (PNH) is an acquired hemolytic disease associated with intravascular hemolysis and thrombosis.

Case:

A 12-year-old African female with SCD was initially found to have isolated thrombocytopenia which later progressed to pancytopenia. Bone marrow done was consistent with the diagnosis of SAA. She was started on cyclosporine as Immune suppressive therapy (IST) and responded transiently but eventually became transfusion dependent. 12 months later her PNH clone was increased and she declared herself with PNH. At this point she underwent transplant with unrelated donor (9/10 matched) without any complications. Currently she is 12 months post transplant with no evidence of PNH clone, stable counts and hemoglobin electrophoresis consistent with sickle cell trait.

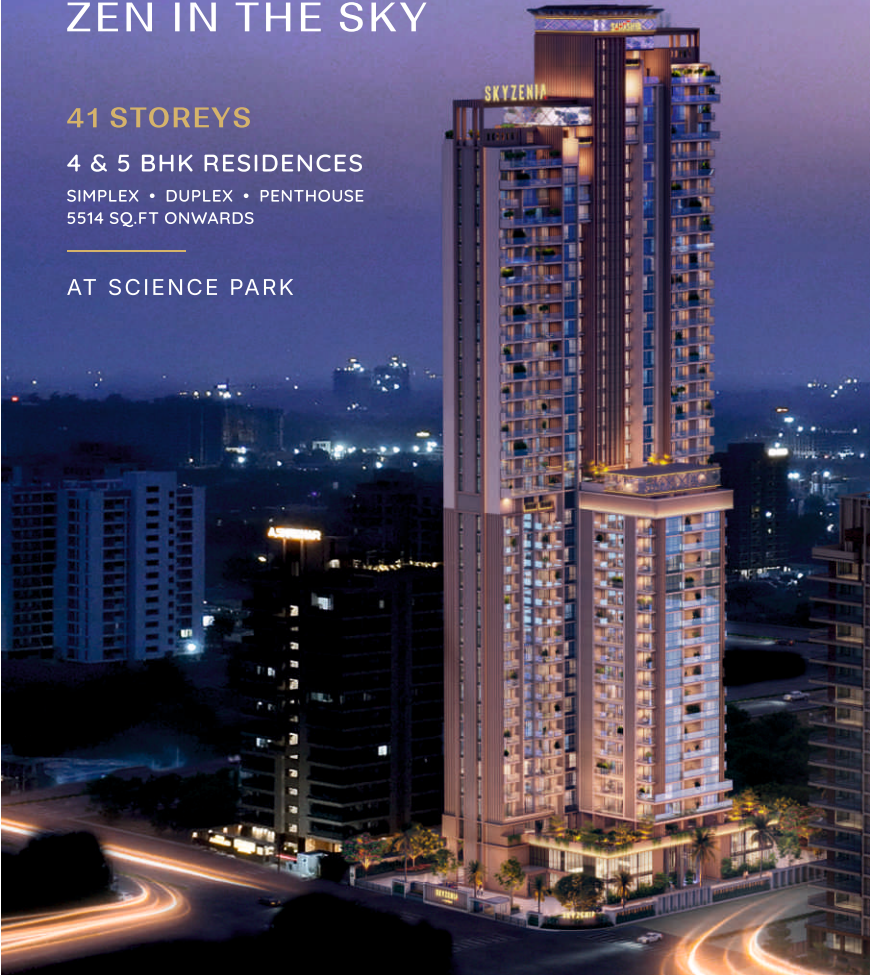

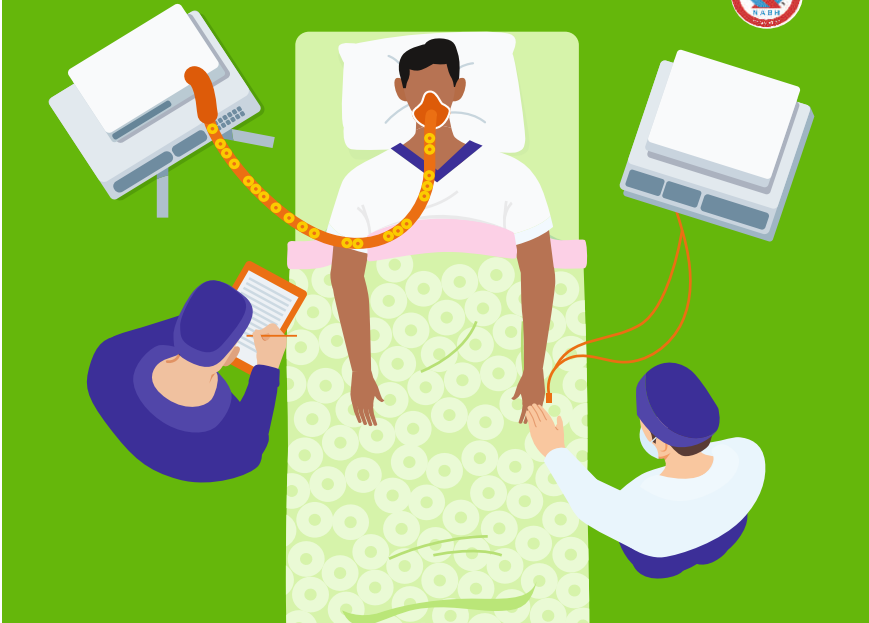
