Dear Members,  
Season's Greetings,

First of all we congratulate our incoming IMA GSB PRESIDENT Dr Devendra Patel and vice Presidents of each zone. We wish them good luck. At present burning issue to our medical fraternity is from government. First they told physician to start covid hospital then they say to give beds at their private hospitals. They followed it. Then they enforce to work at civil hospital.

If there is no big setup they ask IMA members to duty in government hospital in covid ward. Then they ask to take care of other established covid centre. Also if they say no then they threaten and say that with the help of police they will pick up them. If a physician ask about proper facilities for the doffing , donning ventilators, generators then they say it is not of their concern. The doctors have to perform their duties at any cost.

Our demand for compensation of rupees 50 lacs to private practitioner is also not heard at all.

At present 34 medical students attending covid duties and being infected with Corona virus in different medical colleges in the state. With the numbers expected to rise in the next few days we request a special care for the students living in the college hostels.

19th paragraph in the statement of Honourable Union Health Minister Shri Harsh Vardhan's statement in Parliament acknowledges the contribution of Health care workers during this pandemic. It faithfully conceals the morbidity and mortality of doctors, nurses and health care workers. This indifference to the sacrifice of doctors and health care workers is the reality of Covid 19. It appears that they are dispensable. No nation has lost as many doctors and health care workers like India. Doctors suffer 4



times mortality of ordinary citizens and Private Practitioners suffer 8 times mortality on the same scale. To feign that this information doesn't merit the attention of the nation is abominable. If the Government doesn't maintain the statistics of total number of doctors and health care workers infected by Covid 19 and the statistics of how many of them sacrificed their life due to the pandemic, it loses the moral authority to administer the Epidemic Act 1897 and the Disaster Management Act. This also exposes the hypocrisy of calling them corona warriors on one hand and denying them and their families the status and benefits of martyrdom. While the brave soldiers on the borders countenance the enemy they do so with enormous risk to their personal self. Yet none of them bring home the bullets to be shared with their families. On the contrary the doctors and health care workers not only get infected in the line of their national duty but also bring home the infection to their families including children. To treat these martyrs indifferently is national sacrilege. To tell these families and children to fend for themselves is injustice of highest order.

Honourable Minister for state Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey has stated that public health and Hospitals come under states and so the insurance compensation data is not available with the Union Government. This amounts to abdication of duty and abandonment of the national heroes who have stood up for our people. IMA finds it strange that after having formulated an unfriendly partial insurance scheme for the bereaved families to struggle with the ignominy of the Government disowning them altogether stares at them.

In recent years, many countries have made enormous advances in medicine, but too many have neglected their basic public health systems, which are the foundation for responding to infectious disease outbreaks.

Part of every country's commitment to build back better must therefore be to invest in public health, as an investment in a healthier and safer future.

#### Subject- Reporting of Vaccine preventable diseases (VPD) cases

We would like to appreciate the role of IMA in supporting the government in various goals of public health importance like Polio eradication, Measles-Rubella elimination, Maternal & Tetanus elimination etc. The government of Gujarat especially appreciates the unparalleled contribution of IMA in supporting the MR campaign.

As you are aware that current COVID-19 pandemic has hampered various public health services, including vaccination services and VPD surveillance. As per WHO, UNICEF & GAVI estimates, globally at least 80 million children are at risk of vaccine preventable diseases (VPD) such as Polio, Measles/Rubella, Diphtheria and Pertussis.

The Government of India (GOI) & Government of Gujarat (GOG) has also put emphasis on essential healthcare services including immunization & VPD surveillance. These VPD cases are investigated & samples are collected & tested at WHO accredited labs.

We cannot afford to miss a suspect VPD case at this stage. Besides early detection gives us opportunity to identify outbreaks at the earliest, respond rapidly and thus reduce the impact of outbreak on morbidity and mortality. In view of this, you are requested to inform and appeal your members to report all suspected cases of VPD cases at the slightest suspicion or even when in doubt. The contact details are mentioned below.

The suspect case definitions for VPD is as follows

- **AFP Case- Sudden onset weakness or floppiness in any part of the body in a child < 15 years of age with onset within last 6 months or paralysis in a person of any age in which polio is suspected.**
- **Suspected Measles/Rubella- Any person with fever and maculopapular rash with any one of the 3 'C' - Cough / Coryza / Conjunctivitis Or Any person in whom clinician suspects measles/Rubella infection (e.g. post measles pneumonia without rash at time of diagnosis)**



- **Suspected Diphtheria-**An illness of upper respiratory tract characterized by Laryngitis or pharyngitis or tonsillitis AND Adherent membranes on tonsils, pharynx and/or nose.
- **Suspected Pertussis-** Any person with a cough lasting at least two weeks with at least one of the following: Paroxysms (i.e. fits) of coughing/ Inspiratory whooping/ Post-tussive vomiting/ Without other apparent causes OR Apnoea (with or without cyanosis) in infants (age <1 year old) with cough of any duration OR If a specialist physician strongly suspects pertussis in a patient with cough of any duration.
- **Suspected Neonatal tetanus-**Any neonate with a normal ability to suck and cry during the first two days of life, and who between 3 and 28 days of age cannot suck normally and becomes stiff or has convulsions/spasms (i.e. jerking of the muscles) or both OR any neonate who died of unknown cause during the first month of life.

You are requested to notify details of suspected case like Name of patient, fathers name, Address and Mobile number to RCHO/Designated Immunization officer and SMO (WHO-NPSP). The contact details of the concerned RCHO/SMO (WHO) are attached as annexure for your easy reference.

Kindly note its syndromic surveillance so report cases who have symptoms as mentioned in case definitions above. Also I request you to appeal to have high level of suspicion among AOP colleagues for reporting such cases.

## Spare medical students from Covid-19 duty: IMA

Ahmedabad: Indian Medical Association (IMA) on Saturday wrote a letter to CM Vijay Rupani, urging the state government not to involve medical students in Covid-19 duty. 'Some officers are arm-twisting the medical fraternity.. The government would be responsible for any untoward incident involving the medical students,' stated the letter. The letter cited notifications of the central government's HRD ministry and state government to discontinue the educational work. 'The central government's health and family welfare department has issued a

notification on June 16 not to involve medical students in duty. Even then, medical colleges are coercing the students into Covid-19 duty which can be detrimental for their mental and physical well-being,' mentioned the letter. Experts said that Covid-19 duty has remained a bone of contention between the students and health machinery in the state. On the other hand, the hospitals said that the students form backbone of the public health system when regular strength of the doctors is not available. A senior hospital administrator said any government decision is binding on the medical colleges.

# Gujarat govt asks med students to pay fee

The notice issued on August 10 asks students to deposit fees amounting to Rs 3 lakh. The deadline to submit the fee is September 10.

The annual fee of a student studying at a government self-financed medical college/GMERS medical college runs into lakhs of rupees as compared to the meagre amount charged from students of the six government medical colleges in the State.

A medical student has to pay an annual fee up to Rs 6 lakh in such colleges. If s/he gained admission in management quota, the fee comes up to Rs 12 lakh. According to the notice, each one has to deposit a minimum fee of Rs 2.72 lakh for the second semester. The notice also mentions that a late fee will be recovered if students miss the deadline.

The notice has left students worried. They told Mirror, "Third and fourth year MBBS students are performing duty as Covid Warriors. They have not studied since lockdown in March. Then why is the government charging such a high fee from us?"

"I am in my fourth year of MBBS. I am performing Covid duties as in-

structed by the government authorities. None of us have been taught anything since March and yet the government is seeking fees in lakhs from us. Instead of encouraging us for having risked our lives to serve people, they are seeking a fee for something they have not even done. We are not asking for the fee to be waived. The government can either reduce fees or provide relief in some other form," said a student of a government self-financed medical college in Ahmedabad.

Another student from the same col-

lege said, "If the government can order schools to reduce fees, why can't they apply the same rule for medical colleges? School fees run into thousands of rupees while we pay lakhs. Not only have we been taught nothing since March, we are also dispensing duty as Covid Warriors. Does that not count for anything?"

The students added, "We have raised the issue with the government, asking it to reduce or cut out fees. The government has said it will look into the matter." Medical students and par-

ents went to meet Chief Minister Vijay Rupani, Health minister Nitin Patel as well as State BJP chief CR Paati with their grievances and received a positive response.

# Gujarat govt enrolls medical students as Covid Warriors then asks them to pay fee

GMERS and government-run self-financed medical colleges issue notice asking students to deposit second semester fee amounting to Rs 3 lakh by next month; students who haven't been taught anything since March, ask: 'Does our Covid service count for nothing?'



When parents of school-going children sought reduction in fee due to the Covid-19 situation, Gujarat government responded immediately, instructing private school managements to do away with fee. But when it comes to government-run self-financed medical colleges, the government seems to be singing a different tune. Students of these colleges have been asked to deposit fees amounting to lakhs by next month. This, even when third and fourth year MBBS students are performing their duty as Covid Warriors and haven't attended classes since the lockdown was first imposed.

As per details available with Mirror, following a recent circular from the health department, self-financed medical colleges run by the municipal corporations and Gujarat Medical Education and Research Society (GMERS) have issued notices to undergraduate medical students seeking fee free second semester.

### Private docs must get benefits akin to govt docs: IMA writes to min

The problems for the state government on the Covid-19 front don't seem to end. Alleging arm-twisting of private hospitals and doctors by district collectors, Indian Medical Association has written to the health minister that if corrective steps are not taken, then private doctors will resort to symbolic agitation. The IMA representation comes amid a rising number of Covid-19 cases and friction between resident doctors and hospital administration. IMA's memorandum to health minister Nitin Patel read: "Private doctors are cooperating in the fight against Covid-19. However, across several districts private hospitals and doctors are being threatened by

collectors in the name of the Epidemic Act. We have received complaints in this regard from Bhuj, Gondal, Gandhinagar, Gir-Somnath, Jamnagar, Botad and Godhra. IMA chief Dr Chandresh Jarodosh told Mirror, "We are offering full support to government machinery. However, some collectors pressure private hospitals to reserve beds of Covid-19 patients. They also try to rope in private doctors for Covid-19 duties.

"Families of government doctors who die during, or after, Covid-19 duty get Rs 50 lakh compensation. Beds and ventilators are reserved for them. However, the same benefits are not extended to private doctors." He added, "Paucity of doctors at government hospitals is largely responsible for the current situation.

Hiring of doctors in government hospitals has been put on backburner for years. During the Covid-19 pandemic, the government offered 11-month contracts to doctors at Rs 30,000 per month. Whereas consultants were offered Rs 1.2 lakh salary for the same tenure on contractual basis."

**Ahmedabad:** In a letter to Gujarat CM Vijay Rupani on Thursday, members of the Indian Medical Association (IMA) Gujarat chapter criticized the allegedly heavy-handed behaviour of some collectors. The members requested government intervention. "Doctors - who are treating Covid-19 patients even at the cost of their lives for past six months - are facing coercion and intimidating behaviour by collectors of Bhuj, Gondal, Gandhinagar, Gir-Somnath, Jamnagar, Botad and Godhra. IMA condemns it in the strictest of words," states the letter.

The letter added that such behaviour with the doctors is putting lives of the citizens of Gujarat in danger. "If such behaviour and actions are not stopped, members of Gujarat chap-

ter of IMA would be forced to protest," the letter states. Dr Chandresh Jarodosh, president of IMA Gujarat chapter, told TNN that they got the complaints that doctors are expected to admit patients at hospitals and work there and also offer their services at government-run hospitals.

So the reviewer also doesn't know about the author. This procedure is adopted since years.

We would like to mention here, the determined and committed efforts made by our enthusiastic and dynamic Past President Dr. Yogendra Modi and Hon. Secretary of IMA GSB Dr. Kamlesh Saini along with our ex-editor Dr. Amitbhai P. Shah and Dr. Urvesh Shah (GCS medical college Ahmedabad) for helping us in maintaining our indexation status with Index Copernicus International. Dr. Urvesh Shah's painstaking efforts in up loading all the issues of GMJ on Index Copernicus website made them available there.

- ❖ Basic laboratory facilities are also provided in these centres like Haemoglobin estimation, Blood grouping, Random Blood sugar, Hb Electrophoresis for diagnosing Thalessemia, Urine Albumin, Sugar, HIV Test and Blood Test for Malaria Parasite detection.


